### Stroud Area Regional Police get new motorcycle

The 250cc motorcycle is liquid cooled and substantially quieter than the more traditional police motorcycles, making it better suited for patrols on neighborhood streets, according to representatives of Pocono Cycle and Service Center, which donated the bike to the department.

A liquid-cooled, four-stroke, single-cylinder engine and automatic CVT transmission with a Kehien carburetor and three-gallon fuel tank.

That's mechanic-speak.

Translation: Here's a free 2008 CF250T-3 V3 motorcycle for the financially strapped Stroud Area Regional Police Department, compliments of Advanced Door Technologies in East Stroudsburg.

It goes up to 65 mph, gets up to 50 miles to the gallon and is great for patrolling residential neighborhoods that want to see more police presence.

And this donated motorcycle, which SARP now adds to its three others, means thousands of dollars in savings for the department, said ADT Vice President George Mason.

ADT owner Fred Budetti presented the new motorcycle at Wednesday night's SARP Commission meeting.

CF motorcycles are produced by CFMoto, Asia's largest bike manufacturer, Mason said. "Police officers are our customer base, so it's appropriate," he said.

SARP Chief John Baujan said the department is very grateful for the gesture.

"These are financially trying times for everybody, so we do whatever we can to achieve our goals at affordable costs," Baujan said. "This donation is a real home run. We use our other bikes for speed enforcement, but we can use this one for residential area patrols. It's easy to drive, maneuverable, great on fuel and has some really good features."
